Planting scheme

The majority of the funds were to go on the planting scheme however if this did not go ahead at its envisaged scale, funding may be available for new banners to enhance the Town Centre.

The Deputy Town Clerk advised that due to the previous installer going into receivership, it may not be possible to put banners up or bunting as soon as was intended, as an alternative contractor may have to be identified.
