195/18 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN – PROJECTS

The full schedule of Neighbourhood Plan policies was reviewed with the following updates:

EN3 Signage needed at the nature reserve in view of the recent fire.

DH1 & 2 Possible provision of a bespoke fingerpost or an obelisk could be designed and located in Crescent Gardens to indicate the compass points and how this influenced the town's design. This would require permission from Fylde.

TR4 The Town Clerk circulated some notes from Ian Brookes regarding cycling schemes. Input from the LSA cycle group would be very useful at a future meeting. Input into the LCC / Blackpool Council cycle study is also desirable.

SS2 It has been some time since any updates were received about The Island site.

TR2 The Town Council would like more information about real-time bus signage.

Planting scheme

The Deputy Town Clerk has spoken to Fylde Council's Parks department about the next stage of the planting and they have mentioned the bulbs will be ordered later this year for autumn planting. Fylde Council will undertake the tree and shrub planting; Friends and volunteer groups are required to plant the spring bulbs.

- h) The Deputy Town Clerk to contact Amy Docherty to find out expected delivery dates of the bulbs she has ordered so we can organise help with the planting.
