(OXFORD ROAD, GRETDAL AVENUE & DORSET ROAD,
LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intends to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Fylde:
 - i. Oxford Road from its junction with St Leonards Road East to the junction with Headroomgate Road.
 - ii. Gretdale Avenue from its junction with Oxford Road to the junction with Dorset Road.
 - iii. Dorset Road from its junction with St Leonards Road East to the junction with Oxford Road.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibitions will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1800 hours from Monday 10th May 2021 until Wednesday 12th May 2021 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Oxford Road: St Leonards Road East – Headroomgate Road

Gretdale Avenue: Oxford Road – St Leonards Road East – Headroomgate Road

Dorset Road: St Leonards Road East – Headroomgate Road – Oxford Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing patching works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
