(BACK ST DAVIDS ROAD NORTH, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Back St Davids Road North, Lytham St Annes at the rear of No 264 St Davids Road North, Lytham for approximately 15 metres.
2. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0845 hours on Thursday 20th May 2021 until 1700 hours on Monday 24th May 2021 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate works to repair a defective sewer to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
